

CINTACUR ORAL SUSPENSION

COMPOSITION

Praziquantel	2.50g
Selenium (sf. Sodium selenite)	0.05g
Excipient qs	100ml

PHARMACEUTICAL PROPERTIES

Praziquantel is an anthelmintic from the pyrazino-isoquinoline family which is very active on tapeworms. Its action is exerted on both adult and immature forms. On the pharmacological level, Praziquantel exerts its action in various ways including in particular the induction of a paralyzing muscular contraction and the destruction of the integument of the cestode. It is rapidly absorbed from the digestive tract in all species. His metabolism is complete and rapid. The addition of selenium in the preparation aims to mitigate the effects of deficiencies in this trace element widely encountered in sheep farming in Morocco.

TARGET SPECIES

Sheep and goats

INDICATIONS

Treatment of tapeworm in target species.

ADMINISTRATION AND DOSAGE

CINTACUR is recommended orally in a single dose of 2.00 ml suspension / 10 kg bodyweight, corresponding to 5.0 mg Praziquantel.

CONTRAINDICATIONS AND INTERACTIONS It is not recommended to use another source of trace elements when using CINTACUR.

SIDE EFFECTS If the general conditions of use are respected, & if the recommended doses are respected, CINTACUR is well tolerated by the target species.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

- Respect the recommended dosage.
- Shake well before use.
- Keep the product out of the reach of children, protected from light and at a temperature between 15 $^{\circ}$ C and 25 $^{\circ}$ C and RH of 60% \pm 10%
- . Destroy the container after use



WITHDRAWAL PERIOD

STORAGE CONDITIONS

- 2 years in the original packaging, protected from light and at a temperature below 25 $^{\circ}$ C
- Stability after opening the container: 3 Weeks
